Key TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon Statistics and Facts:

- The 2023 TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon takes place Sunday, October 15th, 2023
- The event brings approximately 25,000 runners, walkers, spectators and supporters to the City of Toronto every year
- The 2023 TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon participants represent over 78 countries, including Canada, and all Canadian provinces and territories
- The TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon was awarded an <u>Evergreen Certification</u> from the Council for Responsible Sport in recognition of its outstanding sustainability initiatives, a distinction held by only a select few marathons in the world
- This year's participation is record breaking, with registration for the marathon and half marathon selling out over a month before race day
- Participants may run, walk or wheel the following distances in-person on October 15, 2023 or virtually throughout the month of October: marathon (42km), half marathon (21km) and 5 km
- The TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon serves as the Athletics Canada national marathon championship race and is an Olympic qualifier

KEY QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. What is the purpose of the Pre-Race Press Conference?

The Pre-Race Press Conference is a platform to share all of the great news and progress that happens in preparation for the marathon weekend. The press conference is the kick-off event for race weekend and provides an opportunity to highlight the Elite Athletes that come from all over the world for this prestigious event in Toronto.



2. Why hold the Pre-Race Press Conference today?

The Pre-Race Press Conference takes place in the same location as the TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon Running, Health and Fitness Expo immediately before it opens at the Enercare Centre in Toronto. It serves as the opening event of the Expo and the kick-off to race weekend.

3. What is the Running, Health and Fitness Expo?

The Expo is a free running exposition that brings together over 40,000 supporters and participants over two days leading up to the TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon. The Expo highlights new gear, nutrition and fitness products, features TCS Charity Challenge charity partners, and hosts Speaker Series panel discussions with Elite athletes.

4. Who are the organizers and sponsors of the marathon weekend?

7. Are there any records or achievements the marathon is hoping to set or break this year?



In addition to records that may be set on the race course, this year, approximately 20 participants are Guinness World Record hopefuls. Several notable achievements have already been made by the TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon this year, including:

- Record breaking participation, with all distances sold out by race weekend, and registration for the marathon and half marathon sold out over a month before race day
- The TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon is one of a select few marathons in the world to be awarded an <u>Evergreen Certification</u> from the Council for Responsible Sport in recognition of its outstanding sustainability initiatives.

8. How do local businesses get involved and benefit from the marathon weekend?

The world class weekend brings together over 25,000 visitors, athletes and supporters from around the globe annually. With more cheer stations along the race route than ever before, local businesses will experience all of the economic benefits that come with hosting this kind of prestigious event. This year, the TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon has teamed up with local businesses along the route who #ChooseTOCelebrate with exclusive deals for race participants.
