Iconic TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon Returns to the City for 2023

TORONTO, ON (October 12, 2023) - On Sunday, October 15th Toronto welcomes the return of one of Canada's premier running events, the TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon. The event brings more than 25,000 elite and recreational runners together with spectators from over 70 countries annually, serving as the Athletics Canada national marathon championship race and having doubled as an Olympic qualifier.

A pillar Toronto event and internationally renowned race, the TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon prides itself on its impacts "beyond the run". The TCS Charity Challenge provides the unique opportunity for participants to customize their race experience by choosing to run in support of 159 charity partners this year, and has raised over \$50 million for charities since its inception in 2003. The TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon has committed to sustainability efforts through every facet of the event, having been awarded an Evergreen Certification by the Council for Responsible Sport, a distinction held by only a few marathons in the world. What's more, the event's 2023 feature charity partners include Canadian sustainability champions Trees for Life and Trans Canada Trail.

With the world-class marathon underway this weekend, some roads in the city will be temporarily closed as runners and walkers hit the pavement, and local businesses, friends, family and neighbours choose to celebrate with community events and cheering competitions along the race route. As always, the TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon works closely with the City of Toronto, Toronto Police, Toronto Transit Commission and City Councilors to minimize disruptions to residents.
